RÕUGE PARISH TOP SIGHTS TO VISIT

1 RÕUGE VAATETORN PESAPUU PESAPUU WATCHTOWER

Pesapuu vaatorni tipust avanevad maalilised vaated Ööbikuorule ja kaunile Võrumale. Torni kõrgus on 30 meetrit (ülemine vaateplattform asub 27 meetri kõrgusel) ning välimuselt meenutab ta kahe linnupesaga puud.

The Pesapuu watchtower is 30 meters high (the top observation platform is 27 meters from the ground) and it resembles a tree with two bird nests. The watchtower is eye-catching during both the day and the night. In the evening, lights of different colours are turned on to shed light on the so-called bird nests or observation platforms and the so-called golden egg on the top of the tower.



2 RÕUGE ÖÖBIKUORG RÕUGE PRIMEVAL VALLEY


Ööbikuorg lummab oma erakordsest kauni loodusega ja kevadeti kajava ööbikulauluga. Oru nõlvadel saab puhata, matkata, avastada vesioinaid, kiikuda külakiigel ning külastada Rõuge muinastalu.

The best-known part of the Rõuge primeval valley complex is the Ööbikuorg (Nightingale Valley). It borders the ancient castle hill from the north and measures 300 metres in length and 12-15 metres in depth. In spring, especially around when European bird cherries bloom, the valley is filled with singing nightingales – hence the name of the valley.



3 EESTI EMA MONUMENT THE MONUMENT TO THE ESTONIAN MOTHER

Monument kajastab meie köigi tulevikulootusi, värtustab eesti naist emana, väljendab tänutunnet, liidab rahvast ning annab meile kindla sõnumi, et kestame rahvana ajast aega. The Monument to the Estonian Mother is meant to demonstrate appreciation for the Estonian woman as a mother, to express gratitude, and to value the survival of our people. Hans Sissas (1933–2012), who has recounted the stories of Estonian deportees and authored many memoirs, initiated the idea of a monument to the Estonian mother, and lead the efforts to have the monument completed.



4 MÕNISTE TALURAHVAMUUSEUM MÕNISTE RURAL LIFE MUSEUM

Mõniste Talurahvamuuseum on vanim vabaõhmuuseum Eestis. Külastajat ootab ees Löuna-Eesti talu läbi sajandite, Mõniste üldajalugu kivijäst tänapäevani, 19. ning 20. sajandi taluhooned ja hoonesisustus ning 1930. aastate talurahvakauplus.

Mõniste Rural Life Museum is the oldest open-air



museum in Estonia. The exposition offers an excellent overview of the local rural life from the Stone Age till the first half of the 20th century, providing a rare opportunity to visit a wooden lavvu, a threshing barn used as a dwelling, several other barns, a granary.

5 FILMI VARGAMÄE KÜLASTUSKESKUS FILMI VARGAMÄE VISITOR CENTRE

Suurfilmi "Tõde ja õigus" võttekoha rajatud külastuskeskus, kus saab näha filmist tuttavaid kohti, hooneid ja rajatisi. Kompleks on unikaalne, sest osa sellest on autentne eesti talumajapidamine ja teine osa kuulub filmimaaailma.

Filmi Vargamäe – the place where the shooting of the Estonian movie "Truth and Justice" took place in 2017 and 2018. The buildings and settlement in this location were initially established for movie purposes only. However, the movie location became so special and homely that the film makers decided to keep it. This marks the start of the Filmi Vargamäe Visitor Center.



6 METSAVENNA TALU FOREST BRETHREN FARM

Metsavenna talu – talu, mis pakub enneolematut punktriturismi. Võimalust osa saada metsavenna retke raames ühest Eesti ajaloo järgust koos metsavenna punkri külastusega. Peente okaspuurpalkidega vooderdatud punker on kaevatud mäenõlva sisse. Punkrisse on sisse ehitatud magamisnarid ja pisike laud.



In Metsavenna Farm on the border of Estonia and Latvia, you have a unique chance to search for 'Forest Brothers' in their hiding places in the course of a Forest Brother Expedition, visit their underground bunker, listen to true stories, sing the songs of Forest Brothers with the owner of the farm.

7 EESTIMAA LÖUNATIPU LOODUSE ÖPPERADA A NATURE STUDY TRAIL IN THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT OF ESTONIA

Eestimaa lõunatipu looduse öpperaja pikkuseks on 4,8 km ja selle jalgsi läbimiseks kulub kaks kuni kolm tundi. Lõunatipu looduse öpperada algab Naha talu suure, neljameetrise ümbermõõduga tamme alt ning hakkab kulgema riigipiiri vahetus läheduses, mistöötu peab kindlasti kaasas olema isikut töendav dokument.

A nature study trail in the southernmost point of Estonia is about 4.8 km long and it takes a couple of hours to walk it through. The trail starts under the oak-tree with a perimeter of about 4 metres in Naha farm and runs very close to the state border, so make sure you take your ID with you.

8 METSA KÖLAKOJAD PÄHNIS WOODEN MEGAPHONES

Kölakojad on kolmest hiidruuporist koosnev installatsioon. Kolmemeetrise läbi- mõõduga metsa kölakojad pakuvad külastajatele kohta mõtisklemiseks ning looduse häälte kuulamiseks.



Deep in the forests right on the edge of Estonia, three gigantic wooden megaphones (RUUP) stand, scattered between dark-barked fir trees. Ruup invites you to read forest sounds and offers hikers a possibility to rest their feet and their minds. Here, you can sit, sleep, think and listen. You can select between a small and a large view, depending on which direction you look in the Ruup.

9 LUHASOO ÖPPERADA

LUHASOO NATURE STUDIES TRAIL

Luhasoo maastikukaitsealal kulgev öpperada on 5 km pikkune ring, mis on osaliselt kaetud laudteeega. Raja keskpunktis oleval rabasaarel on ööbimiseks väike metsaonn. Matk tasase maastikuga Luhasoo pakub vaheldust Võrumaa muidu künklikule loodusele. Raba rahu ja vaikus aitavad närvidel linnakärist ja päevaaskeldustest puhata.



The nature studies trail running through the Luhasoo landscape protection area is 5 km long and partly covered with a boardwalk. On the bog island midway along the trail there is a small cabin in the forest where you can spend the night. Hiking around the flat landscape in Luhasoo presents a good alternative to the hilly landscape typical of Võru County, while the stillness of the bog allows you to get away from the hustle and bustle of the city and your everyday routine. The trail is fully marked.

10 VIITINA MÖIS VIITINA MANOR

1542. a. andis Tartu piiskop Johann möisa dr. jur. Jürgen Holdschner'ile, 1598. a. müüs tema poeg Cremon Bertram Viitina Otto v. Vietinghoff'ile (arvatavasti on siit pärilt ka kohanimi). Vietinghoffide suguvõsa käes oli mõis 1782. aastani, mil läks tütre kaasavarana von Kruedener'ile (Kründener'ile).



Beautiful manor in Viitina, that was first mentioned in 1542. It thereafter belonged to the von Vietinghoffs for a long time, but later changed hands many times.

11 ROGOSI MÖIS ROGOSI MANOR

Rogosi mõisa külastusel saab teada mõisa ajaloost, tänapäevast ja tulevikuplaanidest. Mõisakooli ajalugu aitab mõista muuseumikeldris asuv väljapanek. Mõisa pärliks on veinikelder, kus on säilinud vana (arvatavasti keskajast) veiniseinastik ja sealtagab maa-alune käik Jaanivariku tammikusse.



Ruusmäe village Rogosi manor (17th–19th century) is the only preserved castle manor in Estonia. The manor houses a museum (clock tower, museum basements), accommodation and seminar rooms. The earliest records of the manor date back to 1603, when it was purchased by the Pole Stanislaw Rogosinsky. This is where it gets its name from.

12 ANDRI-PEEDO TALU ANDRI-PEEDO FARM

Andri-Peedo talus on võimalik tutvuda tänapäevase moodsa farmiga, kus kasvatatakse kitsi ning valmistatakse kohapeal erinevaid maitsvaid kitse- piimatooteid.



Andri-Peedo Farm mainly operates in raising goats and making goat milk products. The farm is interesting for children and adults alike.

13 SUURE MUNAMÄE VAATETORN SUUR MUNAMÄGI

Suur Munamägi on Baltimaade kõrgeim tipp (318 m merepinnast). Vaatetornist avaneb selge ilmaga 50 km raadiuses vaade Eestimaa loodusele. Vaatetorn valmis 1939. aastal ja selle kõrgus on 291 m.



This is a significant place in the heart of Southern Estonia, the tower at the top of which opens to the breathtaking views up to 70 kilometers away. Suure Munamäe observation tower was built in 1939, it is 29.1 meters high and its peak is located 346.7 meters above sea level.

14 HAANJA PUHKE- JA SPORDIKESKUS

JA SUUSARAJAD HAANJA SPORTS AND RECREATION CENTRE

Võru maakonna talvine tömbekeskus. Erineva pikkuse ja raskusastmega suusarajad ning lastele kelgumägi. Puhakeskuse kõrval on lasketee. Kevadest sügiseni sobivad Haanja rajad matkamiseks ja jalgrattasõiduks, samuti rulluisutamiseks ja rullsuusatamiseks.



Here you will find skiing trails covering four distances (1 km, 2 km, 3 km and 5 km) and the Haanja-Kurgjärve walking & cycling trail (1.4 km). There is a biathlon shooting range next to the skiing stadium with space for 30 competitors.

15 VÄLLAMÄGI VÄLLAMÄGI

Vällamägi on üks Eestimaa suurimaid looduslike pinnavorme. Kõrgus merepinnast on ligikaudu 304 m. Suhteliselt kõrguselt on Vällamägi Eesti kõrgeim, ületades seega isegi Suurt Munamäge.

The 2.2 km long Vällamägi hiking trail gives you a great experience of different heights. Vällamägi is the second highest hill in Estonia, covered with primeval forests and with very steep slopes, it is 303.9 m above sea level. However, if we take the 84 metres from its foot to its top, we can say that it is the highest hill in Estonia by its relative height. Its slopes are very steep in some places (slanting 35 to 40 degrees). Vällamägi forests have been the reserve of fir gene pools since 1992.

16 SIDE JA LAPTOPI MUUSEUM

COMMUNICATION AND LAPTOP MUSEUM

Side ja Laptopi muuseumis saab näha 1969. a telefonijaama, telefoni-aparaate, taksofone, taksofoniputkasid, öhuliine, sidekappe. Esindatud on Eesti Telefoni-Elioni-Microlinki-Emt- Telekom ja Hallo poe meened, samuti suured sildid ja majadel olnud logod. Lisaks üle mitmesaja mobiili-telefoni, mille seas ka NMT vanad mobiiliaparaadid ning suurel hulgjal laptoppe.



In the Communication and Laptop Museum You can find switchboard with cords, a telephone exchange from 1969, telephone sets, payphones + payphone booths, overhead lines, mail baskets, communication instruments. Large Elion-Microlink-EMT-Telia signs and logos that used to be on the buildings. Also over several hundred mobile phones, among them old NMT mobile devices, antennas, and a 13 m cell phone mast. In terms of computers, there are a few desktop computers and twenty laptops. You can make calls inside the museum with a dial phone.
